- FoWY hired a new development director, Kemecia Sewell to assist with fundraising activities. We are all volunteer parents, and the workload is too overwhelming for one or two individuals, it requires a full-time person.
- Principal Appreciation month gift with thank you cards were given to Principal Harris to show the parents at WY appreciate his hard work and efforts towards our students academics and extracurricular activities.
- Fall Gathering-Bunker Chicago was an enormous success (thanks to Alison and Mi-Yeon).
- Annual Fund kicked off at Fall Gathering raised over \$6,500 the next day, our AF campaign is in full swing. The Annual Fund committee set a Goal of \$80,000.00 this year.
- Working with the Alumni committee and various Alumni groups to get the word out for WY 50th Year Anniversary in 2025.
- Grants applications are open until 10/20/23. Get in your grant applications to be considered.
- Communications team did an outstanding job, thanks to Joel, Grace, and others with getting the word out about Fall Gathering and Annual Fund.

- Grants (Megan/Melanie)September
 - 9/12-Sent out notifications to Spring 2023 Grant Award Recipients (7 Recipients- \$13,714 in grants awards). Deadline to use grant Nov. 1st
 - Updated Reimbursement Instructions- check is now the only option for payment
 - 6 of the 7 spring grants- still need the grant and indicated they will use by 11/1
 - Honors Engineering Program (7th grant award-\$1500) had already purchased needed items with dept funds. Their request for alternate items could not be accommodated. [\$1500 award should roll over to this year's grants budget.]
 - Grants Committee notified of this year's budget: fall-\$30,000 spring-\$10,000
 - 9/19: Our committee had a productive meeting- reviewed the fall grants application and guidelines. Edits were made
 - 9/25- Fall Grants application cycle opened as targeted. Deadline for application: 10/20
 - All WY administrators, teachers, and staff were emailed the application with instructions and an invitation to apply.
 - FoWY student reps assisted in getting the application sent to all student club reps via email and Google Classroom page.
 - Fall Grant Cycle communicated in the Weekly.

October

- Continued advertising the open fall grant cycle in the Weekly. DubTV will also run notice.
- As of 10/9, we have received 25 grant applications requesting over \$35,000.
- We have set a next meeting date to begin reviewing the applications shortly after the 10/20 deadline
